

## Course Description

This course is designed to help students achieve good score on their TOEFL® Internet-Based Test, using academic language skills and test taking strategies. Practicing listening comprehension, structure, written expression, and reading comprehension skills that are suitable for nonnative speakers of English to prepare themselves for the Test of English as a Foreign Language, to further their studies at the advanced levels.

## Course objectives

- The purpose of this intense course is to prepare students for the TOEFL® iBT exam
- To further develop their ability to hear and understand, speak, read, and write English
- To improve test scores on the TOEFL exam

## What is TOEFL® iBT and why should we use it?

TOEFL® iBT is the newest form of taking the TOEFL exam. The test is given in English, has 4 sections on reading, listening, speaking and writing and takes about 4½ hours.

Section	Time Limit	No. of Questions
Reading	60-100 minutes	36-70
Listening	60-90 minutes	34-51
Break	10 minutes	—
Speaking	20 minutes	6 tasks
Writing	50 minutes	2 tasks

It is believed that if we prepare students for TOEFL® iBT, they will also be skilled to take any other method of TOEFL exam taking, such as Institutional TOEFL, Computer Based TOEFL and Paper Based TOEFL, etc.

## Who should attend?

This course is primarily for students that aim to attain admission in the universities in the region and US. It is designed for students with High-Intermediate level of English Knowledge.

## Training duration and Schedule:

The training will be delivered three times a week, two hours a day, for a period of 8 weeks. It will have a total of 72 contact hours.

Contact hours per day	2 hrs (two 50 min sessions)
Contact days per week	5 days (Suggested: Monday to Friday)
Total contact hours	72 hrs
Total weeks	8 weeks

Group size will not exceed 12 students.

Minimum number of students to start a course	8
Maximum number of students per group	12

The course will start on September 13, 2010 and will be delivered in 8 weeks.
